To celebrate this day, our school has planned a range of exciting activities that all children can part take in to win house points for their house teams and also earn extra fifteen minutes golden time on Friday. Activities include colouring, designing, making puppets for lower KS1 and for older children a range of reading, maths and writing challenges. To enter the competition, all children **must read or be read to** (depending on age and ability) at least a chapter of any Roald Dahl book of their choice **in addition** to their chosen activity. Books can be borrowed from the school library or any public library. All participants will also receive a certificate to acknowledge their effort.

Alternatively, they are free to come up with their own creative idea on any of Roald Dahl's works. All children **must attach** to their entry a completed slip that states the Roald Dahl book they have read and the pages read. The slip will be given together with their chosen challenges. Please support your children to complete their chosen activities at home and return to school latest by the morning of **Friday 15th September**.

Best works from each class will be displayed in the school library. Parents will be invited to come into the library at a later day one afternoon after school to have a look at the displays. We are very excited about our first library competition this term and look forward to reading all the entries.

We hope you have fun reading Roald Dahl books and doing these activities.
