

Dear Parents/Carers

As you are aware, we have school open for our most vulnerable and also to pupils whose parent(s) are classed as Key Workers. We are trying to keep school as safe as possible for both the children who are in school and also our staff. The guidance for children being in school has been updated further and we can only have key worker children in school when there is no alternative provision, ie if one parent is working from home or is currently not working then the child should remain at home and participate with the online learning being provided, regardless of one parent being a key worker and attending their workplace. For up to date guidance please visit www.gov.uk.

Where a child has to attend school then this should only be on the days where the parent(s) are actually on a shift, so on the days where you are off work your child should remain at home and participate with the online learning.

We have also asked parents to provide their shift pattern to us, without this information we will be unable to offer places for children in school.

Please also be aware that we are now at full capacity within the year group bubbles and are not able to admit any other pupils that have not already attended as key worker pupils. We will not be able to accept children in school either where we are not aware they will be attending, hence the importance of providing us with your shift patterns.
