Dear Parents and Carers,

The last two weeks have gone really well and the children have settled back into school brilliantly. They have all been working so hard at home and in school that the transition has not been as difficult as we thought. Children have been hungrier than usual, as we all snack when we are at home and they have also been extremely tired by the end of the day and especially by the end of the week. I know it will be a relief to all the adults to have a normal routine and normal bedtimes again. Please contact school if you need any help regarding returning to school issues.

Staggered drop off and collection times:

The queue at 8.40am is still huge and we don't really know what is causing the problem. By 8.45am it is much quieter. It might be worth trying a different drop off time. But please remember, doors close at 9am.

Consideration for our neighbours

It can be difficult living right next to a school and usually we have excellent relations with our neighbours but over the last week, parents and carers have been parking across driveways and there have also been reports of children running onto private property. We would always encourage walking to school where possible, even if it is parking just slightly further away from school. It really helps the children's fitness and also the environment.

There have also been reports of unsafe behaviour near the main road by some of our older children. Please can parents ensure children are responsible before they are allowed to walk unsupervised.

School Nursery

We are making some exciting changes to how we run the school nursery from September:

Wraparound Provision: from September Wraparound Provision will be available for nursery children.

Rising 3s places: from September we will be able to offer afternoon places, (subject to availability) to children as soon as they are 3. Parents and carers can choose just to apply for places for one or two afternoons or for the whole week. Some rising 3s may qualify for funding but the option to pay for the sessions you would like is available to all.

<u>Supertots group</u>: from September we are hoping to run a baby and toddler group – 'Supertots', one afternoon per week in school for any adults and preschool children who would like to come along. This session will be run by Mrs Russell, who works in our nursery, but we need regular volunteers to help out also, please get in touch if you are interested. There will be small charge per session to cover refreshments and basic materials.

<u>Virtual Easter Egg Hunt</u>: Our Deputy Head Miss Carter has been creating a virtual Easter egg hunt, look out for more information soon.

Have a wonderful week and here's hoping that things continue to improve and we are back to normal by the Summer.
