Dear Parents and Carers,

It has been a great first half term of the year and the children have settled back into school very well. As you know I will be retiring at the end of this term and I am delighted to be able to let you know that our Board of Governors have appointed a new Head Teacher. He is a fellow Coventry Head Teacher and is currently the Head of John Shelton Primary School in Coventry. This will include sessions around managing toileting, behaviour, fussy eating and sleep.


