Dear Parents and Carers,

It has been a great first half term of the year and the children have settled back into school very well. As you know I will be retiring at the end of this term and I am delighted to be able to let you know that our Board of Governors have appointed a new Head Teacher. Mr Robbie Walker will be your new Head Teacher, starting straight after the Christmas holidays. He is a fellow Coventry Head Teacher and is currently the Head of John Shelton Primary School in Coventry. I have known Mr Walker as part of the Coventry Heads Partnership for many years and we are so pleased that our wonderful school will be in such safe and experienced hands.

Reading Champions

We will be awarding our first reading champion awards in today's assemblies. Children will be presented with this award based on excellent effort so far this year in reading. They will receive a green enamel star which they should wear on their school jumper or sweatshirt.

Black History Month

We have been celebrating Black History Month in school and the children have done some wonderful inspirational work. They have explored the lives of significant figures who have influenced our lives in different ways including, politics, human rights, medicine, science, technology and the arts.

Lateness

Children need to be in school by 8.55 am every day. After this time the children will need to come through the main entrance and will be marked as late. There were 15 children who were late this morning, all of these have missed the relaxed start to the day, chatting with their friends in the cloakroom and have the additional anxiety of having to walk into class late, they also miss out on basic skills time and often the teacher's welcome to the day. The cost of the pool for the month was around £5000 (before electricity costs) which we were able to take out of our Sports Premium funding.
