Thank you to everyone who came to the Parents Evenings this week. It was lovely to see you all and I hope you found it useful to discuss your child's academic progress. The number of parents who booked appointments is below.

In the first week back after half term the school's attendance improved considerably. With one class having 100% and three classes having over 97%. Let's see if we can keep this up! The number of children who are late for school daily remains a real concern for us all.

Next week we will be looking at the quality of teaching of early reading. An external consultant from Read Write Inc (this is the scheme we use) will be observing teaching and providing training and feedback to our Early Reading Team. The aim is to ensure children develop the essential skills to read, pass the Year 1 phonics screening in the summer term and most importantly enjoy reading.



We are still looking for a Parent Governor to join our dedicated and committed team. The Governors meet twice a term on Wednesdays from 4.15 - 6.00pm. The Chair of Governors is Keri Husband who is also a parent. Governors are involved in the strategic direction of the school and are viewed as our 'critical friends'. We would very much like to hear from you if you have a varied skill set and are interested in helping the school to improve.

Unfortunately, we will not be able to run the Parents and Teachers Association (PTA) at Whitley Abbey. Due to work and a number of other commitments the parents who have run the PTA are no longer able to do so. They have been looking for volunteers to take over without success. I would like to personally thank them for the time and effort they have put into supporting the parent and school partnership.

This is a quality performance, and we believe that this sort of exciting experience can make Christmas magical because the children have fun with their friends developing their personal and social skills in the process.
