Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back to school everyone! It has been great to see you all returning after the summer holidays. We have enjoyed hearing about the exciting holiday adventures. The children all look very smart in their new ties. They look smart and think smart!

September is a month of new beginnings in school and there are lots of changes happening for us all. We have been impressed with how well the children have settled into their new classes. They have been reminded what the expectations are. We shared this poem in our whole school assembly on Monday.

S is for the summertime that's ending, the signs begin to show.

- E is for the evenings that get darker as shorter now they grow.
- **P** is for the pears and apples, cherries, too, that hang upon the bough.
- T is for time, time to pick and gather them for they are ready now.
- E is for everywhere in fields and woods where colours glow, yellow, red and gold.
- **M** is for the mornings getting cooler. We begin to feel the cold.
- **B** is for the birds that gather to leave our shores.
- E is for everything that's ripened to be placed in winter stores.
- **R** is the reminder that autumn's almost here. The year again is passing and winter's drawing near.
- Some children wrote their own September poems and shared them with me this week.

Some changes that I would like to let you know about include the implementation of a new Personal, Social, Health and Economic curriculum. We are using the *Jigsaw PSHE* curriculum which utilises a Mindfulness approach. The children have been introduced to the *Jiggies* and *Jerrie Cat.* On Monday they took part in the first assembly and lesson about *Being Me in My World.* The children will have their PSHE lessons on Mondays from 11-12 and they will be taught by their class teachers. We will be utilising floor books to record the learning in. I have witnessed this being used in other schools and the impact on children's learning was fantastic. We will be putting more information about this on the school website if you would like to know more.

The second area of curriculum change will be in the teaching of Religious Education. We, along with many schools will be using the new Coventry RE Syllabus.







Following a review of Homework and after consulting parents, staff and children, we have put together our Homework Guidelines document. There are going to be few major changes to what we are providing.

Homework teaches children how to problem solve. Homework gives children another opportunity to review class material. Homework gives parents a chance to see what is being learned in school. Homework teaches children how to take responsibility for their part in the educational process.

Today we announced the roles and responsibilities for our Y6 children. The staff team spent time discussing which children demonstrated our Core Learning values and our Character values. Leadership and resilience are two essential life skills, and we feel these children should be role models. Congratulations to you all.
