- White socks or grey tights
- Sensible black shoes

- Grey trousers or shorts
- Bottle green cardigan or jumper
- Grey or black socks
- Sensible black shoes

Optional full zip hooded sweatshirts can be purchased via Schoolcomms for PE days during winter.

Essential items

- Free fruit is provided mid-morning. You can send in a healthy snack if your child does not like fruit
- Book bag (not required for Nursery children)

- Children are to come to school in their PE/Games kit on their PE/Games Day.
- Please do not send pencil cases as all stationery is supplied by the school.
- Please remember warm outerwear in the winter and sunhats in the summer.
- Parents are asked to support us by ensuring that their children wear school uniform. Only stud earrings and wristwatches (no smart watches) may be worn, and children are responsible for these (School will accept no responsibility for lost items). No other jewellery is allowed.
- Selected uniform is available to order from the school office. Preloved uniform can be purchased from outside Abbey Oaks.
